Free refill water station

We are pleased to announce that we have been working hard to secure Leicester's first public water

fountain refill station, near to the Cruvff Court - St Matthew's. It is positioned next to the What Cabin. The station has been kindly donated by Cruvff Foundation and Join the Pipe, with the installation funded by The Water Fountain Foundation. We have provided over 700 free water bottles to young people from Taylor Road School and The What Cabin. The free water fountain will help to keep young people hydrated and help to reduce waste, litter and fizzy drinks at the site.

£5000 to spend a penny!

Thanks to a grant of £5000 from Central England CO-OP, we have been able to upgrade the toilet facilities at our Community Hub, St Matthews House. The facilities are used by over 200 people a week at busy times and haven't been upgraded for well over 20 years. We have had new flooring, loos, water heaters and an emergency alarm and they should be fit for purpose for another 20 years!

Adding to the MUGA

After feedback from the local community, we have looked at the lighting located on the basketball side of the Multi Use Games Area and purchased some additional lighting, at a cost of £1,000. Whilst it isn't full flood lighting, it does increase the lighting in the area sufficiently, to enable people to use the basketball, netball and tennis court. Leicester City Council sports department have also kindly donated us an outdoor table tennis table worth £600, which we have installed.

The City Mayor has also kindly arranged for additional fencing, along the footpath on Willow Street, to stop people from walking over the newly planted garden.

Memorial garden

Have you noticed the the changes in the Austin Jackson memorial garden? Isn't it looking great! Gone are the overgrown bushes and no sight of rats running around! Now we have 10,000 spring bulbs, great new picnic benches, nice multi coloured refurbished benches, froggy bins and bear bins. This is now a great place to picnic and spend time with the family.

More Trees in St Matthews.

As part of our vision for a Cleaner and Greener St Matthews, this

year the partnership board agreed to











commit £750 of funding to plant more trees in St Matthews. We were also successful in gaining £700 of funding from Leicester City Council. We have planted 5 trees near to the Multi Use Games Area, 6 fruit trees on Bushy Park and 15 fruit trees near to Wharf Street North. The fruit trees are all dwarf variety and will produce apples, pears and cherries. Also, when the fruit is growing, you will be able to pick the fruit, as they have all been planted in publicly accessible areas. We will be planting at least another 15 trees in the autumn. That is 41 more trees this year. We would like to thank LCC Housing dept, Parks dept and St Matthews TARA for their support with this project.
